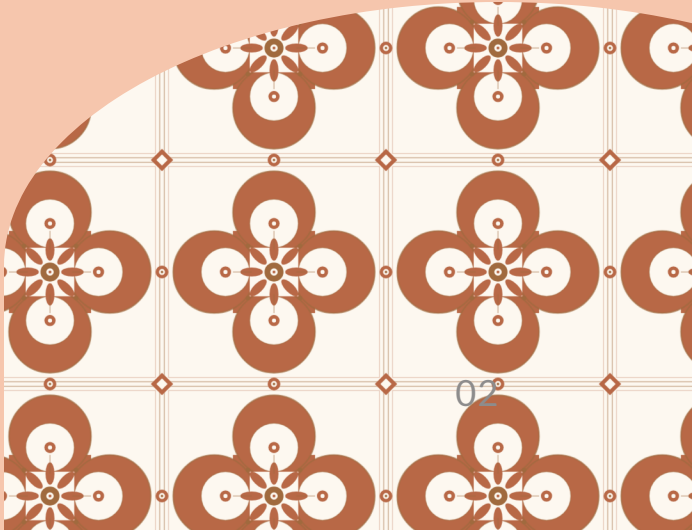
Where it all started for us.
